We are hoping for a variety of price ranges, \$50 and below. The families will choose one large gift and 2 small gifts per child.

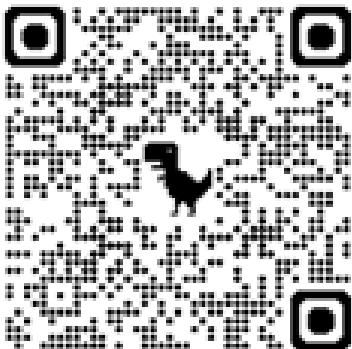
Gift Donation Ideas
