If you've ever felt like you just can't get in control of your money, you're not alone. Join our Financial Peace University class and learn how you can pay off debt, save money, and build wealth.



2024 Financial Summary

2024 offerings were \$687,994 Budget was \$697,125 2024 overall income was \$859,789 Budget was \$799,093 2024 expenses were \$939,390 Budget was \$973,365 2024 net LOSS of \$79,601.

The 2024 budget was passed with deficit of \$174,272 due to large building projects such as the roof and playground. We ended 2024 with a deficit of only \$79,601 so the year ended better than budgeted.

Merger Update

Merging has been a slow process as we go through the legal, financial, paper records and building determining what can be used at Good Shepherd and/or elsewhere. Tables and chairs have been exchanged, and hymnals, paraments, and other items have been brought to Good Shepherd.

It's amazing, the items found at Redeemer: everything from Bibles in German and Chinese, to a Spanish hymnal and a lot of Bible study materials. So

far, besides Good Shepherd, Camp Omega and Trinity in Medford have taken items, we hope to open Redeemer to LCMS churches first and then open it up to other interested parties to move the items.

Along with all the paper goods is the legal transfers and movement of funds to Good Shepherd, this too is a slow process but right now we have transferred over \$15,000.00 to the youth account (this is from the peach sales Redeemer held). Our Endowment funds (your Legacy Fund) will be transferred and allow potential for more giving by the Legacy Committee. Slow and steady we will get the job done and hopefully with God's guidance and help we will be able to use the items at Redeemer to reach out to others in our community and world to spread the love of God. —Dallas Ketchum

Decisions about Redeemer

You have probably heard that Good Shepherd has received a bid for the purchase of the Redeemer property from Sound Church here in town. At a recent Executive Team meeting the group unanimously decided to put forward the motion that our voters accept this offer. While at first the amount offered seemed rather low, in looking at similar sales and the cost of prolonging the maintenance of a vacant church, they decided that this offer made good financial sense. However, finances were not the main consideration. Rather, foremost in our thoughts were what we could do with this blessing to advance the work of God here in our town, and to continue the legacy of Gospel outreach in the name of Redeemer. Look for a voters' meeting in February which will give everyone a chance to express their opinions, ask their questions, and vote their decisions. After this will come the even more significant task of deciding how to implement the funds we are blessed with from this property for the work of the Kingdom of God. —Pastor Greg

Legacy Ministry Fund

Our purpose is to provide a way for our members to leave a personal legacy to ensure continued financial support for Good Shepherd's ministries. Here is a summary of significant activities from the past year:

The committee sponsored our first annual planned giving luncheon to connect members with Synod resources to identify the right tools to help execute a giving plan. 38 members attended this luncheon, which indicates a strong interest in the mission of the LMF. Due to some generous gifts, the Fund grew over 50% and now totals over \$106,000!

We are reviewing for disbursements from the fund and will announce the distributions in the first quarter. Some of the distributions will come from funds designated for music ministry, but we will not be inviting designated contributions going forward.

We have added several new members to the committee and are working with representatives from Redeemer to consolidate their fund into Good Shepherd's. We will keep you informed as we work through it. The Committee would like to thank all who participated in our activities, and special thanks to the members who made donations to the fund. We are excited to see the continued growth of this fund and the impact it will have on our ministries.
