


#### Easter is A Time of New Life

#### Discipleship

The two unavoidable things in life are ...death and taxes.

I could have put together a series on paying taxes, with April 15 coming up, but I'm going with the even more fun subject of death. The spring quarter of Bible study will be focused on final things. We're going to explore questions like...

What does the Bible say death is?

How should I approach death? Is death good? Bad? A little of both? What's the best way to grieve?

What actually happens when I go to heaven?

What about when Jesus comes back? Will I be raptured up to heaven? What will my body be like when God raises me from the dead? How do I live today with the best approach to what's coming some day?

These may not sound like "cheery" topics, but they're incredibly relevant. A good understanding of what God says about death gives us incredible hope for today and eternity. Oftentimes we avoid this topic, try to keep our kids away from it, or ignore the future.

If you're intrigued and would like to spend 6 weeks studying with other

Christian brothers and sisters, I encourage you to sign up for a discipleship group. We'll dig into Scripture, spend time talking about the real questions we have on these topics, and support each other in prayer.

I'm excited that this spring we'll also have a women's study that's exploring the Armor of God from Ephesians 6 and a Men's Study that's digging into the wisdom of the book of James.
