

Joyful Generosity

I was listening to a podcast on Joshua 17:14-18 and it really hit me: the people come and say they want more, and Joshua doesn't say no. He says go and get

it. If you want to bring God's kingdom about in some new place, go be part of it. Will it be challenging? Of course, but they can do it. Joshua believes. And he believes that the one who's really making it happen is God. It's his presence that makes the difference.



It's a safe place to find community and When the Executive Team first looked at this year's budget, we were a little frustrated. Costs have gone up on things out of our control. We also faced increased costs for staff and ministry. Why? Because our teams want to do more. We could have said, 'Hold it, just settle for what you had last year.' But the Exec Team had the Joshua vision: if you want to do more, if you want to bring more of this land into the Kingdom, then go for it. It will be hard work, but we believe God is underneath it all making it happen and giving this vision, and we believe the congregation will be excited to support it.

> We want to do more. We confirmed over 20 students and had over 40 in Confirmation class last year. This year we've got even more kids, so we're dividing into two classes. We have more kids in youth group, and kids who want small groups, so we need more mentors and more time to train them up. We have two Sunday School times instead of one. Why? Because we have more kids, and it's exciting! We need more time and resources to train teachers and equip our next generation.

We want Worship to grow our ability to impact people. We have more Discipleship groups than ever before. We have the Women at the Well, who just held an event for more than 80 women, and regularly host small groups, Bible studies, and more. And Men's studies. And Celebrate Recovery. And young adults ready to start their own groups. And Faithful Families events. And the dream of Pregnancy Options to save unborn children and support struggling moms right here in Owatonna.

Our Local Service and Outreach and World Missions Teams are dedicated to using the dollars gathered here to impact our community and the world. We want to send a team to Bangladesh to help equip locals to share the Gospel in their own languages. And...I could keep going. The vision is big.

We're like the tribe of Joseph coming up to Joshua and saying: we want more. Will you help us do it? Yes, the budget is bigger this year, but it's because we're asking to do more Kingdom work. We did the math: if each family gave just \$250 more per year we could cover the expenses. \$21 a month. That's not hard for many, and some could give more. Others can give what they're able. As Paul says, we give from the heart from what we have, not from compulsion or what we don't have.

We give with our gifts, our time, and our talents. There's plenty of work to do. When we serve God with time, talent, and treasure, we know we're experiencing something deeper. What we do serving God will last forever and we'll see it all come together in heaven and the resurrection. -- Pastor Dan





Sharing the Gospel in Every Language

Project Video Gospel Audio Players are small, solar-powered devices loaded with the Bible, worship songs, and gospel teaching in local languages. These players allow people, even those who cannot read or who lack internet access, to hear God's Word in their heart language. With the help of local pastors, Project Video's Asia team places these players directly into the hands of those who need them most.

This year, we are also introducing the Distribution Evangelism Kit: a portable projector, power box, and USB filled with gospel media. Unlike noisy, unreliable generators, the power box makes film showings possible in rural villages and equips media teams to share the gospel in places without electricity.
